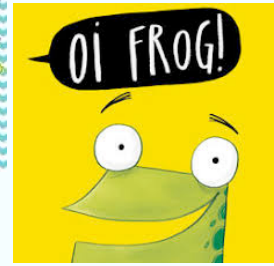
Tues: Trip - Funtastics, PM - lets fill buckets and make some extra playdough for prenursery.

Week 4: Snail and the Whale

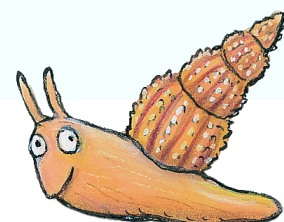
23rd July - 27th July

30th July - 3rd Aug

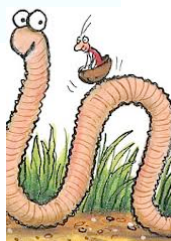
Mon: AM W5, strengthen our investigative skills! PM Mugshot and identity cards as we join the gang.
